Clay Modeling Workshop

Clay Modeling is one of those things that is almost irresistible to adults and kids alike. Who can resist picking up a cool piece of clay and squooshing and squeezing it; letting it ooze between your fingers or rolling it around on the palm of your hand? Not many can deny the desire to 'play' with clay; but, in this day and age, there are so many kinds of clay where do you begin? We will be demonstrating to participants **Hardening Clay** – the kind used to make vessels, figurines, plaques, etc. This type of clay hardens by kiln firing, oven baking air-drying. The end result being a solid, hard, dry material with varying levels of durability.

Modeling – is interpreted by piecing together smaller units of clay, or by coiling clay, participants can create figures, pottery, art ceramics, napkin holders, tiles anything they so desire. We will give them ideas and projects they can follow. There is plenty of room for individual thinking. Any type of clay can be modeled.



Overview

This is a challenging workshop that gives participants the opportunity to express their creative side. Each person will be given a demonstration on the procedure for making a sculpture using clay. There is lots of scope for creativity.
